

How to equip a furnished apartment 1/4

In France, the definition of a furnished apartment is: Any housing *«equipped with a sufficient number and quality of furniture to allow the tenant to sleep there, to eat and to live appropriately in the light of the exigencies of the everyday life»*.

In order to help Landlords of Furnished apartments to maximize their chances of renting their furnished accommodation, Paris Rental has prepared a detailed list to this effect.

THE KITCHEN AND THE BATHROOM ARE IMPORTANT ROOMS!

THE KITCHEN

Above all, the kitchen must be clean and functional. Built-in furniture makes it much easier to maintain: use a damp, soft sponge and the kitchen is impeccable!

Choose light colors and good lighting, especially underneath the kitchen cabinets, towards the counter tops. Dishes or utensils must be new or like-new. For best convenience, buy white dishware; it's easier to replace chipped or broken pieces.

HOME APPLIANCES

Stove or hot plates

Microwave oven (if possible)

Extractor hood + replacement filters

Refrigerator with a freezing compartment*

Dishwasher

Washing machine (washing / drying, if possible), and Dryer

1 electric kettle

1 coffee maker, preferably Nespresso

* As an indication, a refrigerator must have a capacity of:

100 to 150 liters for one person,

200 to 250 liters for a couple,

250 to 300 liters for a home of three people

350 to 500 liters for four people.

CUTLERY SETS AND DINNERWARE

6 complete cutlery: forks, knives, tablespoons, teaspoons

6 flat plates

6 soup plates

6 dessert plates

2 serving dishes (1 round, 1 oval)

6 water glasses

6 wine glasses

4 bowls or mugs (breakfast)

6 tea cups + saucers

or 6 coffee cups + saucers

1 teapot

1 salad bowl with salad servers

1 tray

Tablecloths or placemats

COOKING POTS AND USTENSILS

1 series of pans + lids

1 casserole

2 pans

Oven dishes (Traditional and Microwave)

1 set of kitchen and carving knives

1 peeler

1 cutting board

1 strainer

Ladle, skimmer, spatula, whisk, grater, scissors, bottle opener, corkscrew, can opener, funnel,

Salt and Pepper Shakers (empty)

1 trivet

6 towels

1 salad spinner

2 potholders

How to equip a furnished apartment 3/4

Feeling «at home» at first glance means finding all elements of comfort to which one is accustomed.

A sure guarantee for the owner to a successful rental!

ENTRANCE

Console Mirror

Coat rack or closet Umbrella holder

LIVING ROOM

A comfortable sofa-bed is a great investment, because it means an extra bed! For an expat tenant in Paris, renting a one-bedroom apartment with a sleeping couch in the leaving room means having an extra room for guests. An apartment offering this option rents very quickly.

In an apartment with several bedrooms, a nice comfortable sofa is sufficient.

Tip: Removable sofa-covers allow to clean the lining at each rental; otherwise, make sure to protect the fabric with plaids and lots of cushions.

Sofa (preferably sofa-bed) Carpet

Two comfortable chairs

Lighting (halogens, lamps, street lamps ...)

Low table Television + furniture

Bookcase or shelves + some clean books Pictu

(Paris, guides, restaurants ...) Desk + chair (when possible)

DINING ROOM

Curtains or window blinds

Buffet, storage unit Carpet

Table + chairs Curtains or blinds

Lighting (lamp, chandelier) Sideboard

BEDROOMS (for each room)

Nightstands BEDS
Bedside lamps for reading Main bedroom

Wardrobe with hangers

Queen size bed (160 cm preferably x 200 cm)

Dresser, storage unit Guest room

Lighting 2 single beds or double bed (150 cm x 200 cm)

Blackout curtains (often required) Den: sofa, bed, table or desk and chair



How to equip a furnished apartment 4/4

BED LINEN (white cotton, new or like-new)

For each bed:

2 fitted sheets

2 mattress underpads

2 pillows, pillowcases with protection cases

Duvet + 2 sheets + 2 duvet cover

2 sets (duvet cover + 1 or 2 pillowcases according to small bed or big bed)

LINEN FOR SOFA BED

2 pillows mattress underpads 1 fitted sheet sheets and pillowcases

Tips:

Reputed experts in bedding recommend putting two mattress pads on top of one another for optimal mattress protection, rather than a plastic mattress pad that is uncomfortable and conducive to perspiration. Keeping your mattress clean is worth the purchase of two mattress pads per bed!

Same thing or the pillows, an extra pillow case helps to keep pillows clean.

Remember to make an inventory of these items as you go. And with each restocking, update your inventory! When entering the apartment...and leaving, the tenant will be aware of the tate of the inventory that was entrusted to him/her. If anything is missing or ripped, the tenant is responsible and has to replace it.
